Kingswell's History

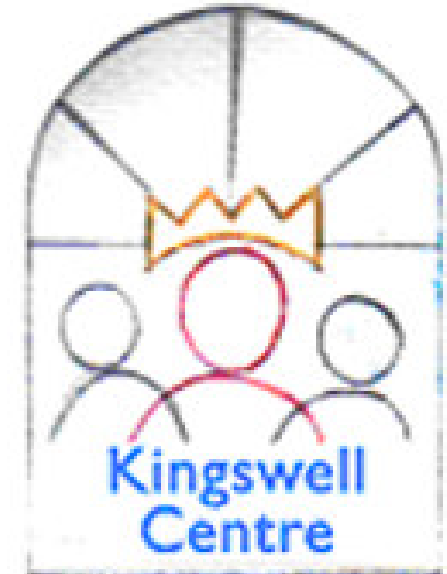
